- Wednesday Intercede for Healing/sin Read: James 5:16, Numbers 12:13, Job 1:5

<u>Thursday</u> – Intercede for Healing/sin Read: Numbers 21:7, Ezra 9:5-15, Exodus 34:9, 1 Kings 13:6

Friday – Intercede for Saving Read: Romans 10:1, Acts 7:60, Acts 12:5, Psalm 25:22

Saturday – Intercede for Saving Read: Deuteronomy 9:18, 25-29; 1 Samual 12:19, Ezekiel 11:13, Joel 2:17
