Engaging the Holy Spirit — A Daily Walk

As you spend time in prayer, focus each day on the Scripture verses and embrace the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life. Pray for the Holy Spirit to guide you and direct you in your life according to the promises of God's Word. Begin in prayer asking the Holy Spirit to guide you into all truth and to lead your heart to surrender to the Holy Spirit's leading in your life. Then read the Bible verses as you claim the Holy Spirit's presence and working in your own life. Take time to be quiet and still and allow the Holy Spirit to speak to you as you listen. Write down what the Holy Spirit reveals; you will know it is the Holy Spirit because it will be in accordance with God's Word.

Monday — Focus on the Holy Spirit as the Counselor, the Revealer of Truth and Understanding - Read: John 14:15-17, 25-27; John 16:7-14; Isaiah 11:2; Ephesians 1:17; Isaiah 4:4
Reflections: What is God saying to you?

Tuesday — Focus on the Holy Spirit as the voice of Truth - Read: 1 John 4:6; Isaiah 30:31; Haggai 1:12; Ezekiel 1:24
Reflections: What is God saying to you?

Wednesday — Focus on the Holy Spirit as the One who Reveals Jesus to our hearts - Read: Galatians 4:6; Philippians 1:9; 1 Peter 1:11; Luke 4:18
Reflections: What is God saying to you?

Thursday — Focus on the Holy Spirit as the One who Reveals God to us Read: 1 Corinthians 6:11; 2 Corinthians 3:3; Job 32:8; Isaiah 63:14; 1 Peter 4:14
Reflections: What is God saying to you?

Friday — Focus on the Holy Spirit as the One who brings us into the presence of God - Read: Romans 1:4; Romans 8:2; Romans 8:15
Reflections: What is God saying to you?

Saturday — Embrace the Guiding and Directing of the Holy Spirit for your Life
Isaiah 11:2 — Spirit of Counsel and strength
2 Corinthians 4:13 — Spirit of Faith
Zechariah 12:10 — Spirit of grace and supplication
Isaiah 28:6 — Spirit of justice
